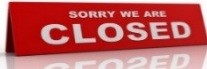

On the lovely sunny days we are singing together in the garden. Songs brings back many memories and give joy.

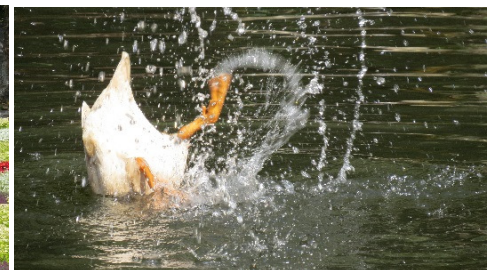
