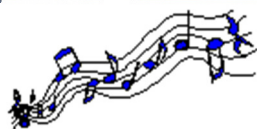
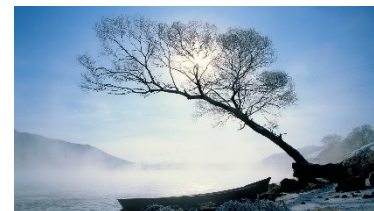

We have the community bus twice a month. In June we went to Pataka in Porirua, and also drove around the bays. Drives with the bus are a highlights for our outings.

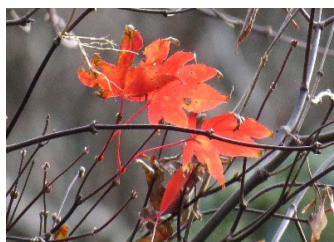
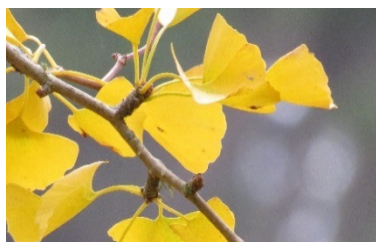
Keeping the existing skills are very important in our program. Paul is a Work Therapist. He makes and assists projects for our members including the interested ladies too.



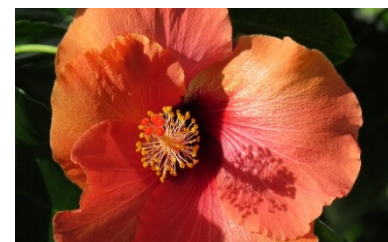
Our days are always interesting, we are never bored. Our staff members always have ideas for activities and entertainment.
