Thank you to the Lottery Grants Board for a grant of \$2,000 to be used for outings and classical music sessions.

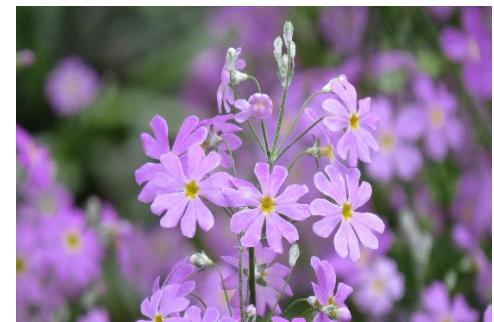
